Dear Mr. Abraczinskas,

Between September 24 and 26, 2019, Chemours and its contractor Weston Solutions, Inc. (“Weston”) performed emissions testing for GenX Compounds at the Vinyl Ethers North and Polymers facilities at Fayetteville Works. This testing was conducted during the first product campaigns in 2019 for EVE at Vinyl Ethers North and for CR at Polymers. The Vinyl Ethers North testing was performed at the Vinyl Ethers North carbon bed and Division stack, and the Polymers testing was performed at the Polymers stack.

The final reports from the testing, prepared by Weston, are enclosed, and they are being submitted pursuant to Paragraph 8.b.i of the Consent Order. The Vinyl Ethers North testing report is also being submitted pursuant to the requirement in our air permit (No. 03735T45) for quarterly testing of the Vinyl Ethers North carbon bed commencing May 13, 2019.
