On March 1, 2019, Chemours submitted its proposal to retain Charles River Laboratories for the human health (mammalian) toxicity studies and EAG Laboratories for the aquatic life (ecological) toxicity studies under Paragraph 14 of the Consent Order. On March 11, DEQ approved the use of Charles River Laboratories, indicated it was “still reviewing Chemours’ request to approve the use of EAG Laboratories,” and asked a series of detailed questions on both laboratories. Since that time, Chemours has been working with both laboratories to compile the requested information and provide responses to DEQ’s questions. The final responses from the laboratories are enclosed here.
